Our New Heating Boilers

Following the approval to proceed with the installation of our new boilers, preparations have started in the choir vestry for this to take place. However, the installation of the boilers is now programmed to start in early November 2024. The gas connection work by the churchyard south gate is expected to be carried out in October 2024. As with all alteration works there will be some disruption, and we hope you will bear with us whilst it is being done.

A big thank you to all of you who have been involved in getting us this far and who have contributed and continue to support our Warm and Welcoming fundraising. This means St Mary's will carry on having heating, and it assists with our move towards net zero carbon in the future.
